

**Declaration of Conformity** 

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and council on Registration, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals (REACH) AMD: 201 16/07/2019 19/01/2021 17/01/2022

IPT Ltd. supports the goals of REACH (Registration, Evaluation, and Authorisation of Chemicals) which are consistent with our own commitment towards responsible use and handling of chemicals.

The European Union passed new legislation on June 1, 2007 that oversees the registration, evaluation, and authorization of particular chemicals within the European Union community. REACH requires that all existing and new substances be registered with the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

After review of the legislation and most notably the definition of an "article" as defined in EC Regulation 1907/2006, Title II, Chapter 1, Article 7.1 (a) and (b), it is within the view of G4 MPS Ltd. that our products are considered "articles." However, according to the definition in 7.1 (b), registration of an article is only required if it contains a named substance that "is intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of "use

On 19 January 2021, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) published the 24th update of the REACH Candidate List. Two (2) new Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) were added. Hence, the total number of SVHCs on the Candidate List increases from 209 to 211.

Further additions to this list were added on 17th January 2022, bringing the total to 223 substances.

The full list of restricted substances is published in the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) issued by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) updated on 17 January 2022 and is available from:
